Brother Sir Knights:

It was a great turnout for the Flagler Beach 4th of July parade. The Color Corps proudly led the Knights of Columbus contingent caring the Stars and Stripes, along with the KofC flag and the Papal flag. It was a hot day but we all endured even though the truck that was supposed to carry the non-marches did not show. It was a wonderful event to celebrate our nation's Independence (**see page 5**).

Father Manny Lopez, Santa Maria del Mar's new pastor, joined us in the parade immediately after celebrating his first mass at SMdM. At the beginning of Mass the Color Corps marched in and installed the flags back in the sanctuary where they belong and have been missing for far too long.

The July business meeting was well attended, for a mid-summer meeting with many of our members out of town on vacation. Fr. Manny attended the meeting and discussed two projects he would like help on from the knights:

- The 1st was the purchase of a new tabernacle for the chapel. This would allow for extended hours of adoration and keep the Body of Christ safe. The tabernacle would be permanently installed and the one selected was silver with gold highlights. There is an anonymous donor that will cover at least 60% of the tabernacle cost. There is a request that Assembly 2810 & Council 10514 participate in the purchase of the tabernacle. - The 2nd project that Father discussed was a memorial wall for veterans and 1st responders that would be a display of pictures on the wall of the gathering area. We formed a committee of PFN Robert Calabrese, Captain Guy Deluca, CCC Frank Consentino, and FN Bryant Perszyk to help Father get this started.

Sir Knights I must make another appeal of all to recruit new members. There is a 4th degree exemplification coming up in Jacksonville on August 24th at Assumption Catholic Church, 2403 Atlantic Blvd., Jacksonville, FL. Candidates' registration begins at 9:00AM with the exemplification beginning at 12:00 Noon. At this time we have no candidates. That is terrible. We all know 3rd degree members, let's talk to them and ask them to take the step up to full knighthood. We are the visible arm of the order and add dignity and pride to the functions where we attend. Get the word out.

Installation of officers will take place on Aug. 22nd at Santa Maria del Mar Church beginning at 6:00 PM. It will be a combined installation of our Assembly and Notre Dame Council 10514.

I pray that God will again unite our parish under the guidance of Father Manny. Mary, Queen of the Knights, pray for us and guide us through this Fraternal year.

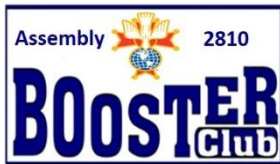
BOOSTER CLUB


