I recently had the opportunity to participate with the Assembly coffee and donut team at the VA clinic in Daytona Beach. I must say it is truly a rewarding experience to serve these men and women that are coming for medical treatment. Many are just happy to sit and talk often they are alone. All appreciative of our presence. I encourage all Sir Knights to at least try a turn, you won't be sorry. We currently have four teams that take a turn every four months and spend about 3 to 3.5 hours at the clinic. We serve the second Tuesday of every month. I want to remind each team to communicate in advance so everyone knows who is going to show up. Team captain call your team members a few days in advance to remind everyone of their commitment. As you may have seen in the Santa Maria del Mar bulletin we are starting the memorial wall in the gathering area in earnest. Tony Gasparino will be collecting the pictures of military and first responders from the parish. This includes family members and they can

be grouped by family. The assembly will also help with the funding for this endeavor.

I had the honor, along with PFN Tony Gasparino, of accepting an award for the assembly during the 4th degree exemplification in Jacksonville. The "To Be a Patriot" award was presented by Vice Supreme Master Robert Anderson, leader of



the Desoto Province. Established in 1985 the "To Be A Patriot" Award annually recognizes the three best patriotic programs conducted by 4<sup>th</sup> Degree assemblies each fraternal year. Entries are judged at the district, provincial and international levels.

The other two winners were from Arizona and Tennessee.

The write-up in the Supreme Knight's Award Session brochure was as follows: Assembly 2810 holds an annual fundraiser benefitting the Military Order of the Purple Heart (MOPH). Over the past eight years, Assembly 2810 has raised over \$65,000 for the MOPH. This year, they held a dinner dance which raised over \$5,000 for the MOPH.

This is a true total assembly award since it takes into account the number of participating Sir Knights and the percentage of Knights participating.



#### **INSURANCE REPORT**

### Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. Like most awareness-raising campaigns, Life Insurance Awareness Month was created because there is an overwhelming lack of understanding of life insurance, its uses, its benefits, and its variations among the general public. A recent survey found that more than 75 percent of people polled did not have a personal financial advisor, even though 68 percent of them said their opinion of the current economic conditions was somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable.


