FAITHFUL NAVIGATOR REPORT – Bryant Perszyk



Worthy Brother Sir Knights,

I pray that this newsletter finds all my brothers and their families' safe during this pandemic that has us all hunkered down in our homes. We have been in "stay at home" mode for over 6 weeks now as we ride out this virus.

We held our first online Assembly meeting this past week, with over 30 Sir Knights joining in. Thank you all that joined us for the meeting. At the meeting there were no further nominations of candidates for the 2020-21 fraternal year so I cast one vote for the nominated slate of officers. Congratulations to Guy Deluca who will be our Faithful Navigator starting July 1st (**see officer list, page 5**).

We discussed the proposal to have yearly awards for our Veterans, local police, fire fighters and 1st responders. Nominations for the awards will come from all 3 of our local councils (SMdM, St Mary's, and Mother Seton). The award statues will cost approximately \$600. The awards will be given out at a special mass on the Saturday after Veteran's day in November. The motion passed with unanimous support.



The originally scheduled dinner, to support the PAWS of War organization, to be held on May 19th was put on hold due to the current pandemic shut down. We will reschedule after the county is opened back up.

The Assembly received a certificate from Sir Knight Robert Reed, PSD, PFM for donating

\$300 to the state wheelchair mission. This donation will provide funding for two additional wheel chairs for our Veterans.

I have been in contact weekly with the VA clinic in Daytona Beach. They are still closed for walk-in appointments. They do not anticipate being open in May. This being said the May team will not be serving donuts and coffee this month. It was mentioned that caution should be exercised in providing this service even when the clinic is reopened. The nurse I talked to said that the number of cases of virus connected illness they are handling has increased the past two weeks.

I would ask our Knights to continue to pray for our country and the world to survive this terrible ordeal. The Knights that have participated in the online rosaries, Stations of the Cross, and Masses have been inspiring and exhibit what the KofC is all about.

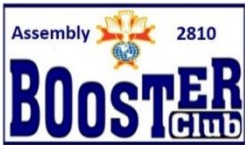
BOOSTER CLUB


