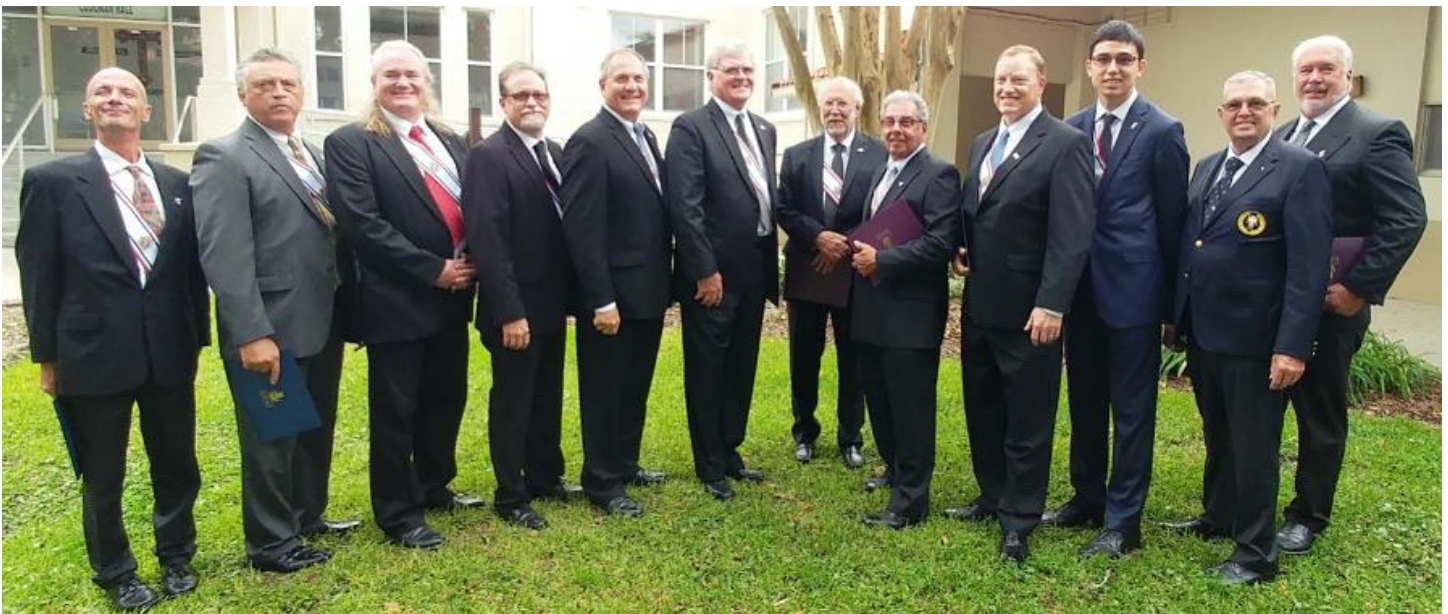
Assembly: Sir Knight Mike Tennyson and Sir Knight Jim St. John (see photo of new Assembly 2810 members below).

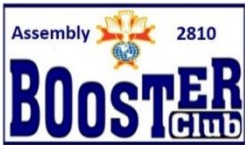
## BOOSTER CLUB

## INSURANCE REPORT Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. Like most awareness-raising campaigns, Life Insurance Awareness Month was created because there is an overwhelming lack of understanding of life insurance, its uses, its benefits, and its variations among the general public. 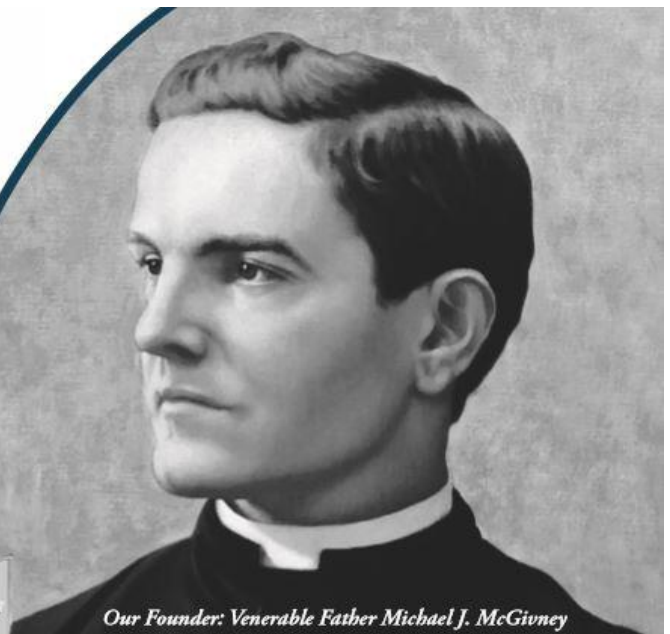
