At St. Mary's Parish Hall

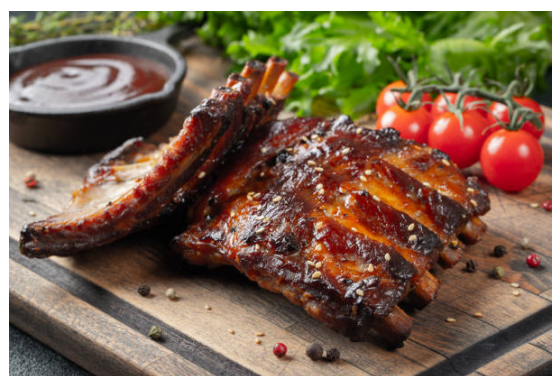



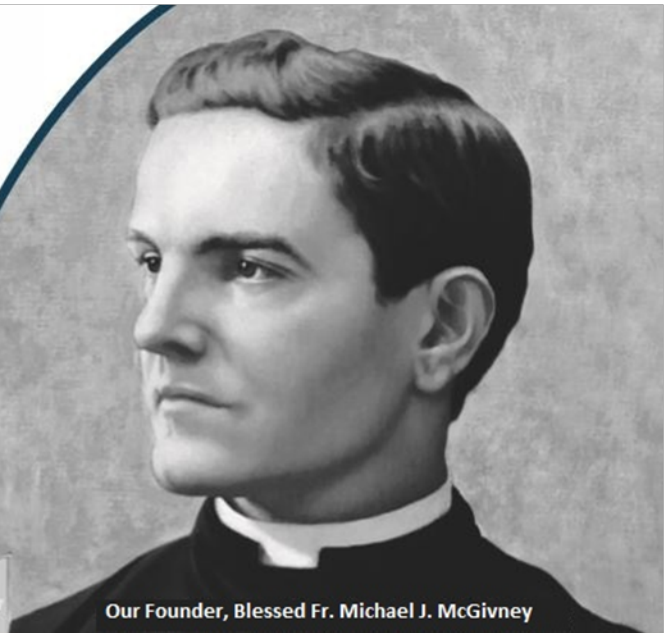
