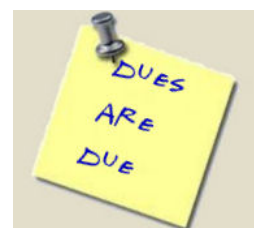

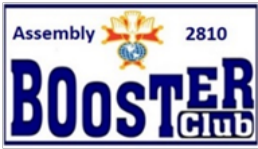
Are you interested in becoming an Assembly Officer? We are taking nominations now.
