

The Knights of Columbus Color Corps is the visible arm of the Fourth Degree, a patriotic degree within the Knights of Columbus.

It's a group of Sir Knights who participate in religious and civic events, often seen in parades or at wakes, to demonstrate their loyalty to God, their Church, and their country.

The Color Corps, with its distinctive regalia and swords, embodies the Knights' commitment to patriotism and Catholic citizenship

The Fourth Degree, and by extension the Color Corps, was established to encourage active Catholic citizenship and foster patriotism among Knights.

In 1910, the Order was reorganized, leading to the formation of the first Fourth Degree Assemblies and the establishment of the Supreme Master position.

The ceremonial sword carried by the Color Corps symbolizes Christian Knighthood and is a visible reminder of the Knights' dedication to the Church, the Eucharist, and their country.

The Fourth Degree, and the Color Corps specifically, emphasizes the importance of patriotism, encouraging members to be active and loyal citizens.

The Color Corps also serves the community by participating in events like wakes and funerals of deceased members, offering support to the family and honoring the departed.
