Candlelight Vigil to Honor Fallen Flagler County Officers

The Knight of Columbus Assembly 2810 attended the candlelight vigil to remember fallen heroes. They lead the procession carrying the council and National Flag behind the Flagler County Sheriff Rick Staley and his wife.

They marched up State Road 100 in silence, with blue candle-lice Week, a tribute that began in 1962 light flickering in their hands. More than 100 people walked in wide "who gave the ultimate sacrifice." unison to pay tribute to Flagler County's fallen heroes.

The Flagler County Sheriff's Office held a memorial Thursday night to pay homage to its officers who have died on duty. A contingent of deputies, retired officers and residents made the half-mile trek from the Kim C. Hammond Justice Center the Sheriff's Office Operations Center, where a candlelight vigil was held.

"Law enforcement officers across the country share a commitment to the communities they serve," Flagler County Sheriff Rick Staley said. "They are not looking for notoriety or recognition. In fact, they rarely hear the words 'Thank you.'"

The department's annual memorial is held during National Police Week, a tribute that began in 1962 to honor officers nationwide "who gave the ultimate sacrifice."

This year marked the first time the department held the memo-The Flagler County Sheriff's Office held a memorial Thursday rial at night, an idea Staley said he got years ago after attending night to pay homage to its officers who have died on duty. A a national memorial for fallen officers in Washington, D.C.

Flagler's three deputies killed in the line of duty are listed on the Officer Down Memorial Page, an international online database for slain law enforcement officers.
