I thank the 4th Degree Team and our District Master, Robert Read for the excellent 4th Degree Ceremony and festivities that were enjoyed by all who attended. I proudly thank our Color Corp Commander, SK Frank Consentino and all the SK members of the Color Corp who attended the exemplification and assisted in this tremendous ceremony.

Many of our Sir Knights are veterans of the US Armed Forces and we know the importance of our chaplains who served with us and attended to our spiritual needs. Many chaplains are heroes who saved wounded soldiers on the battle field staying by their side praying and some gave the ultimate sacrifice to our country protecting our soldiers. I have submitted a document for the Santa Maria del Mar Church bulletin which briefly describes the events and activities our Assembly performs for our church and community. Hopefully this will be published in the very near future.

Now that we are back at Santa Maria del Mar where our charter originated, SK EY Walter will have our Assembly listed in the church bulletin with the list of parish ministries and contacts.

As requested, a letter has been submitted for Father Kaz requesting a meeting to discuss a number of items of importance to our Assembly.

Please continue to pray for our country to become united and to protect us from harm and evil and to heal the world's unrest.

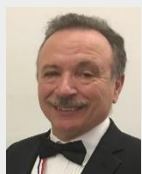

The Purple Heart is the oldest military decoration that is still awarded. The Purple Heart is a combat decoration that is awarded to a member of the U.S. Armed Forces that has been wounded or killed. The Purple Heart Decoration was created by General George Washington in August, 1782 during the

Revolutionary War. There are approximately 1.7 million Purple Heart recipients in our nation's history.

## INSURANCE REPORT

### Raising Awareness About Life Insurance

Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. Like most awareness-raising campaigns, Life Insurance Awareness Month was created because there is an overwhelming lack of understanding of life insurance, its uses, its benefits, and its variations among the general public. Each year, the Life Insurance Market Research Association (LIMRA) puts out the results from a recent survey, and unfortunately, the numbers they report continue to be discouraging.

A recent survey found that more than 75 percent of people polled did not have a personal financial advisor, even though 68 percent of them said their opinion of the current economic conditions was somewhat unfavorable or very unfavorable.

In other words, a majority of those surveyed were uncomfortable with the economy and the uncertainty it brings, yet they did not seek professional assistance. Maybe they spoke with

their friends and family. Maybe they hoped the instability would go away on its own. Maybe they did not know to whom to turn.
