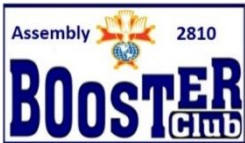
BOOSTER CLUB

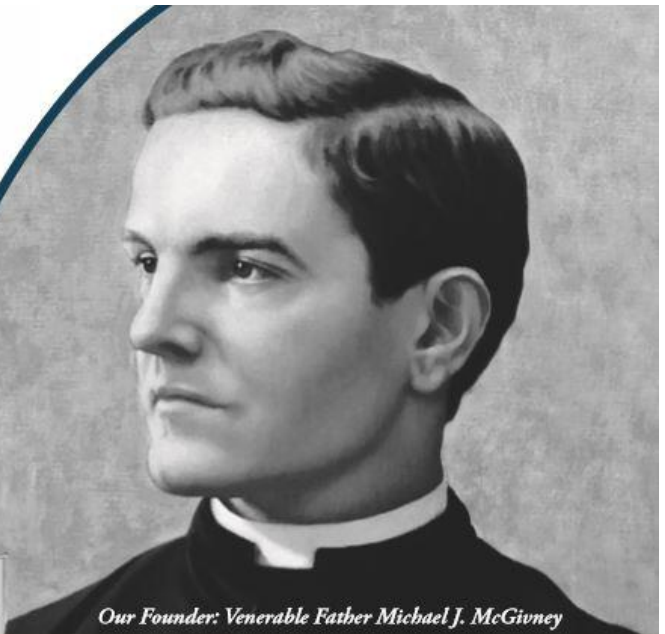
